order.....miracles happens!


In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. The earth was formless and empty, and darkness covered the deep waters. And the spirit of the Lord was hovering over the surface of the waters. Then God said "Let there be light," And there was light. Genesis 1:1-3(NLT) In the beginning, in his order for creation, God created the light first after creating the heaven and earth. Light is essential for visibility, darkness cannot overcome it (John 1:5). Well being can be simply defined as being physically and mentally fit and healthy. A lot of factors contribute to this state of wholeness. Nutrition and exercise are major factors among others such as weight balance, general body check-ups, etc. Women in Christ are not exempted from a need to be and feel healthy. Understanding the importance of health will also make us to be conscious of certain things and be efficient home keepers.

NUTRITION

Nutrition is the supply of materials (food) required by organisms and cells to stay alive. Carbohydrates supply between 50%-60% of the energy required for humans but they are not only the important elements needed by the body. Other nutrition elements are lipid, protein, vitamins, minerals and water. A well-balanced diet should contain adequate amounts of protein, fat, vitamins, minerals, carbohydrate and water.

The Institute of Medicine recommends that adults seeking a well-balanced nutrition get 45% to 65% of their calories from carbohydrate, 20% to 35% of their calories from fat, and 10% to 25% of their calories

from protein.

Carbohydrates are grouped into two major categories: Simple carbohydrates such as glucose and fructose found in fruits, berries, honey, etc. and the complex carbohydrates which are found in whole grains, and many plant-based foods.

- Minerals: People whose intake of food is varied and well thought out, with a well balanced diet will in most cases obtain all their minerals from what they eat. Potassium, Chloride, Sodium, Calcium, and Iodine, are among the key minerals essential for human.
- Vitamins: Eating a well-balanced diet which should typically include fruits and vegetables provides an individual's vitamin requirements. Our bodies cannot synthesize (produce) enough or any of it. So we have to obtain it from our food
- Protein: Protein is found in every cell, muscle and tissue of our body and is also present in many of the foods that we eat. We can easily find it in milk, egg, beef etc
- Water: The major sources of water for the body are fluid intake, food intake, and oxidation of foodstuffs by the body. Water is lost in urine, feces, perspiration, and expired air and should be made up for.
- Lipid: Lipid includes molecules such as cholesterol and triglyceride. These are obtained from certain oils and fat and should be taken with a lot of professional counsel.

All of these elements provide the major energy for us, enhance our immunity, promote the human body's metabolism and strengthen our immune system.

Basically, they keep our body going.


EXERCISE


According to the Online Dictionary, exercise is a body or mental exertion, especially for the sake of training or improvement of health. Also, according to the American Heart Association, exercise can be defined as a subset of physical activity that is planned, structured, repetitive and purposeful in the sense that improvement or maintenance of physical fitness is the objective. There are several forms and kinds of exercise.

The 3 major kinds of Exercise are:

- 1.) Aerobic exercise: It overloads the heart and lungs by making them to work harder than at rest. Examples are aerobic dance, swimming, etc.
- 2.) Anaerobic exercise: They are short-lasting, high intensity activities where the body demand for oxygen exceeds the oxygen supply available". Examples are heavy weight-lifting, running, intense biking, etc. The main purpose is to build power and strengthen the

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muscles.

3.) Agility training: It is any activity that has to do with body balance and co-ordination. Examples are figure runs, ladder drills, cross over etc.

These can further be divided into:

- Strength or Resistance exercises
- Flexibility exercises
- Balance exercises
- Cardiovascular exercises

All these also varies on the level of intensity. They can be light, moderate or vigorous.

Benefits of exercise

- It strengthens the body's different muscles
- Reduces high blood pressure and improves the circulation of the blood
- Improves the quality of sleep
- Improves mental health issues
- Reduces the risk of heart diseases and cardiovascular problems, cancer, diabetes and stroke
- Reduces the risk of osteoporosis
- Reduces obesity and
- Improves the mood and helps you to live longer

As daughters of Zion, lots of things run through our mind: our career, partners and spouses, and family among others. Our maker put all these in our lives to make us healthier on daily basis and not otherwise. educational background: My Primary education was at Christ Anglican Church School, Iporo Ake, Abeokuta after which I proceeded to Lisabi Grammar School, Idi – Aba, Abeokuta for my secondary education between 1983 and 1988. For my tertiary education, I attended the University of Ilorin (B.Agric.) 1997/98 and later on bagged my post graduate diploma (PGDE) 2001/2002 at the University of Ibadan.

Background – what was your growing up like?

Quite wonderful, though not without the usual challenges

How did you meet Christ and when?

Through a neighbour who suddenly took special interest in my family. She would check on us every other day trying to introduce Christ to us and this was around 1987. I gave my life to Christ then, although I backslid for sometime because I didn't understand much of what it meant to be born again as at yet. Later at the university, I kept having encounters with Christ that I couldn't resist until I finally decided to yield all to Him.

Marriage, when and how?

I had a little delay in this area not because I didn't have suitors but my level of knowledge and understanding of God's leading made me a little jittery. But we thank God for His mercies. During my service year, I came home once and my husband-to-be as at then saw me. He couldn't propose then

since I was in a relationship, which later broke up. After the relationship broke up, he came up and asked for my hand in marriage. I delayed him a bit because I wanted to be very sure he was meant for me and after series of confirmation from God and God's people, we got engaged. We later got married on the 27th day of December, 2003 having been through all the counseling sessions and scrutiny from the marriage committee of my church (Jubilee Christian Church International, Abeokuta).

Acting, how did you come into it?

I started out while still in the secondary school with ewi, iroyin kayefi, recitation, and so on. After my conversion, I got attracted to the drama group. Infact that was the first group that got my attention. I discovered that there was something in me that was seriously in love with acting although I was on the choir too. I did a little bit of acting in the Christian Union (CU) drama group at University of Ilorin. But after attending the mount Zion institute of Christian Drama, a fire jumped on me that I have never recovered from and since then, it has been from glory to glory.

What is the secret behind your adaptability to different types of roles in movies? Teachability, sacrifice, willingness to develop my skill, inquisitiveness and most importantly, opening up to the work of grace through the Holy Spirit.

Mention some of the movies you have featured in?

Storms of life, enemy of my soul, ta lo le gbagbe?, majemu ikoko, ipile, lawful captives, nigbati mo wo fin, ta lo ba o se?, the reason, ile ominira, tactics, ekun ikoko, asepamo, semething to hide, ojo ola,

Why acting, why not something else? Primarily calling, secondarily interest.

What is the most challenging role that you have played so far and the challenges you face as an actress and also on locations?

There is no aspect of acting (even when playing minor roles) that is not challenging and that's where the excitement is. Any role that doesn't challenge a drama minister is an indication of trust in the arms of the flesh. It is the Holy Spirit that helps us through any challenge that arises.

What is the difference between make-believe and reality?

You see, as an actor/actress, your passion for acting is revealed in the way you play your roles. You must be able to make people know that you are also being ministered to. This is rated in how the film is received. Though several times we switch roles, the people will only be ministered to when it is real to them. They display emotions according to the trend of the movie because to them, it is reality not just a film. But when you act and your passion is not felt, people will term that film 'make believe' and nobody wants to believe a 'make believe'

Are films real? Films are real. It is a living organism not just something abstract. This is why lives are transformed and destinies are molded through films.

What is the role of your husband in your acting ministry, Supportive? Supportive is an understatement. I always jokingly say that if I come back to this world and found myself in the drama ministry, I will choose my husband again. I doubt if there is another man that can be as supportive as he has been to me over the years.

And please a word for single sisters in ministry:

Just two words; trust and obey. Any one that will trust in the Lord and will be willing to always obey will get the desired results.

Is there joy in acting for Christ? Is it fulfilling, rewarding and encouraging?

Of course yes. There is joy. Joy is a major ingredient of every successful enterprise. The bible says "because thou served a not the Lord thy God with joyfulness and gladness of heart, for the abundance of all things...Deuteronomy 28: 47-48.

Fulfilling because when you see people getting born again through these movies and pointing to your film as an a

SINCLE SISTERS

Ruth 1:22 'So Naomi returned, and Ruth the Moabitess, her daughter in law, with her, which returned out of the country of Moab: and they came to Bethlehem in the beginning of barley harvest.'

The story of Ruth as a single woman who had chosen to follow and be bound to the Lord will be a blessing to us as single ladies. You may not have met Ruth but you sure have met Sade, Chidinma....and YOU! I am so pleased to meet you today. The Holy Spirit will have us learn from this single lady: Ruth who had become bound to the Lord and was returning out of her own country to another. Ruth obviously had challenges that we can identify with even today. We will look at some in this edition.

a. Her identity:

Ruth 2:5 "Boaz asked the man in charge, "Who is that young woman?"

Ruth 2:6 "The man answered, "She is the foreigner who came back from Moab with Naomi".

Ruth was a Moabitess in Bethlehem. She was a Moabitess who had met with the Lord through her mother-in-law. However, she was in a land where the ways and culture of the people was not what she had known for the most part of her life. Although, she was now separate from Moab and had chosen to go with Naomi, she yet was called a MOABITESS: a foreigner.

One challenge single sisters have to deal with in their new locations is identity. Questions like "who am I? Who do I want to be known as? Will I want to be seen as a "CHRISTIAN"? What reputation do I want to

bear? Do I trade my JESUS CULTURE and take on society culture so that I will be accepted?" It doesn't stop at just you many times; it progresses on to 'what do people call me?' 'I want to be called a "Bethlehemite" even though I really am a Moabitess. I want to look like, talk, and act like them'.

2Co 10:12 "For we dare not make ourselves of the number, or compare ourselves with some that commend themselves: but they measuring themselves by themselves, and comparing themselves among themselves, are not wise."

Sister you are unique! The scripture above tells us that comparisons only produce one thing: FOOLISHNESS. Your identity is this; the daughter of the King of nations: your Lord! Do you know how much inheritance you have walked into as a daughter of the king? Tribe, nation of origin, and the many things that look really "cool" do not define you. This is what defines you sister irrespective of where you are located: the presence of the Lord that you carry!

Exo 33:16 "How will anyone know that you are pleased with your people and with me if you do not go with us? Your presence with us will distinguish us from any other people on earth."

The presence of God in you is what gives you identity. Therefore please do not lose it, keep it. The pure wisdom of God in you teaches you how to (like Brother Paul) become all things to all men without displeasing God, that many may by you come to God and not blaspheme His name.

b. Company:

Ruth 2:9 "watch them to see where they are reaping and stay with them. I have ordered my men not to molest you. And whenever you are thirsty, go and drink from the water jars that they have filled."

Looking for and getting Godly Company (especially people like us, with whom you can forget about all the phonetics!) is another issue Godly sisters face. However, Boaz's action here is a type of what the Father does for us. He sets us in homes (Psalm 68:6). Many times we just need to be open to receive the people of different color and race God sets us with. Ruth overcame. She was a Moabitess and may have felt queer among the other women initially, she however left her comfort zone and set out to be with the godly women with whom she could be SAVE AND NOT MOLESTED!

Ruth 2:22 'Naomi said to Ruth, "Yes, daughter, it will be better for you to work with the women in Boaz' field. You might be molested if you went to someone else's field."

Do not keep wrong company, remember Dinah. The Lord rebukes even kings for your sake and orders them not to molest you. However, do not walk out of His covering. Be wise!



c. Income/job:

"Ruth 2:2 One day Ruth said to Naomi, "Let me go to the fields to gather the grain that the harvest workers leave. I am sure to find someone who will let me work with him." Naomi answered, "Go ahead, daughter."

Getting a honorable job; a good source of bread on our table is also another challenge single ladies have a lot of times. Ruth went to pick from the fields. She was not too exalted to be responsible. It is needful to say that as long as that job God provides you helps you make honest gains, it is not ridiculing.

Some of us may however have delays with getting a job, look up to your source, the El-Shaddai, He will set bread on your tables and guide you into fertile lands. Never submit to the pressures to exchange the Lord's temple (your body), your gifts, Grace, callings and the dignity that God has endued you with for mere bread. Remember Esau, he sold his birthright and the Lord said he was a profane man (Heb 12:16). He sought it with tears and never found it. Joseph however waited, Esther waited and in a strange land, God gave them thrones!

Many societal cultures that negate the word of God (homo-sexualism, co-habitation, infidelity before marriage, nudity, and many perverted ideas of man called liberty) which are quite peculiar depending on our different locations are

few words that readily come to mind when you think about singleness are 'alone', maybe, 'unattached'. A single person is one that is not 'coupled' with another in a marriage relationship, not attached (although they could possibly be in a courtship). As it is a preamble to marriage itself, surely it must be a thing of joy to be single and waiting. It should a period of active-joyful expectation and not a time of patient-inactivity.

The life cycle of a butterfly comes to mind when I think of the Christian singleness. To the outside world, the larva while in it's' cocoon; a protective silk case, appears lonely, dry, restricted, sometimes ugly, hard, isolated, and unattractive. In this state, you hardly see movements and the incompletely formed insect appears stagnant- the whole process could take several weeks. However, in that tiny cocoon, one of God's greatest transformations occurs and we eventually see the emergence of the butterfly, beautifully arrayed in some of the best colour combinations no 'ankara' designer can match.

Christian singles are sometimes misled by people in or out of the body of Christ who portray singleness as a thing to loathe and a state to be escaped from at all cost. In the efforts of this 'good-willing people' to 'encourage' singles to look forward to marriage they plant doubt, dismay, despair and sometimes depression. You are, sometimes, made to see yourself as someone that ought to be pitied and not celebrated. Some singles stop attending seminars and workshops to avoid the 'shame' attached to attending yearly with no evidence of progress (i.e. the initiation of a courtship). The single Christians then begins to consider themselves as second-class citizens, and anxiety sets in. (The butterfly-in-making begins to seek a premature exit from its cocoon).

However, in scriptures, we see a different perspective. We have examples of people who were single and yet content. They got married eventually and maintained an undying service to God (e.g. Isaac, Mary, Joseph). Some were single and content throughout their lives (e.g., Daniel, Paul).

Be content with the cocoon while you are wrapped in it, for it is an essential pre-requisite to your glorious exit into marriage. Actually, enjoy your cocoon while it is, for once you are out, you are!

Now you may ask; "What must I do, while I wait?", "How do I make my existence count for much, while in the "cocoon"?"Let's go back to the beginning.

Before God gave Adam, the first single man, the bone of his bone and the flesh of his flesh, He gave him tasks. Adam was asked to care for the things that matter to God. All of God's creatures were put in Adam's care as God's representative on earth. Adam was not waiting in the corner for his 'consolation' (his wife), he was busy. It was never mentioned that Adam was desperate for a wife (although I am sure he had the longings that are common to all men), neither was it mentioned that he was dissatisfied with the state of singleness in which he was. He fellowshipped with God and learnt what it meant to please God.

Take your eyes off of yourself, your needs, your longings and your desires. The fantasies are just illusions and distractions from the devil aimed contending with God's purpose for your life. Burn the romantic novels; destroy everything that seeks to make you a slave to despair and depression. Set your heart on God, His desires, His pleasures, and His delight-those are bigger, and of more eternal benefit.

"I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: Therefore choose life." (Deuteronomy 30:19)


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


targeted at harassing the purity and tenderness of Godly singles who are passionate for God.

"And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God. (Rom 12:2)" Christian families are entrusted with the great task of showing the world how the home is supposed to be: we are the salt of the world, and a city set on a hill that cannot be hidden.

Leaving home for a foreign land should not be seen as a challenge but an opportunity to show Christ, love and good examples to others around us. As Africans (especially Nigeria like I know), our culture is one that supports the home structure as written in the bible. This includes parent-children relationship which is full of respect, responsibility, love and discipline. Most cultures outside of our shores are not like ours; they are either adulterated or completely neglect the God-ordained order in the home.

Our home and relationship should depict us as Christians, just like we cannot hide our accents that when we speak it shows who we are and where we come from. Parenting should be out of love and not of pride. It is not what

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we want them to be but the plans of God for their lives that matter. Remember that we are just custodians of God's heritage (Psa 127:3-Lo, children are an heritage of the Lord: and the fruit of the womb is his reward).

Discipline is one aspect that many parents in Diaspora fail. We tend to forget how we were brought up by our own parents simply because we have changed location. Spare the rod and spoil the child, a meat not well fried will rot in few days. Pro 22:5 says "Foolishness is bound in the heart of a child; but the rod of correction shall drive it far from him". We as parents should not hesitate to use the rod when it is necessary. The Western world while avoiding child abuse tends to neglect discipline and this in most cases is evident in the imbalanced teenagers and adults produced. The use of the rod should not be often as kids tend to develop resistance towards it; nevertheless it is a godly form of chastisement. Parents should also talk to their children more and always be their friend, build a friendly relationship with them and they will tell you all you need to know.

Parenting is a spiritual thing and should be viewed in a spiritual manner. Let's always pray for our children that they will never deviate from God's principles and expectations from them. And we should always remember that the place we reside is not to dictate how we raise our children. Trust God, and He will continue to lead and direct us.
