
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# From the Editor I n Chief

### Reference Scripture: Mark 12:41-44 (KJV)

<sup>\*41</sup>And Jesus sat over against the treasury, and beheld how the people cast money into the treasury: and many that were rich cast in much.

<sup>42</sup> And there came a certain poor widow, and she threw in two mites, which make a farthing.

<sup>43</sup> And he called unto him his disciples, and saith unto them, Verily I say unto you, that this poor widow hath cast more in, than all they which have cast into the treasury:

### <sup>44</sup> For all they did cast in of their abundance; but she of her want did cast in all that she had, even all her living."

Jesus was in the temple and he was sitting by the treasury and saw how people were coming to drop money into it. In our time, imagine Jesus sitting by the offering box and watching how people are dropping in their offerings seeing clearly what each one is dropping and a widow came out with two mites in her hand and she was declared as the only one who gave her best and all.

Imagine the mites as the smallest money in your currency probably 2 cents, 2 pence, 2 kobo etc. And yet Jesus declared her as the one who gave her best and all. Why?

Giving is a topic that many people do not want to hear about nor talk about. As a matter of fact, some have stopped attending church or any religious gathering because they don't want to hear about giving nor give. Giving is a voluntary transfer of property or gift (material, monetary etc.) to another person or group of people. It is important to note that it is a voluntary action. What you give depends on the situation. In the scripture above, the people gave money but God gave us his best and all too.

"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life." (John 3:16 KJV)

God gave an example of how and what should be given; giving his only begotten son shows He gave his best and all. Jesus is the only Son of God and He was given to the world by God. God didn't send angels to come and die for our sins; He gave his only begotten Son setting a pace for all on how and what should be given. God gave out of his love, unconditional love, freely, voluntarily and joyfully. Giving is not by size but by motive, God gave out of love so that should be your motive too. Your love for God and his kingdom should move us to give.

There is nothing you have that is not received from the Lord; all good and perfect gift comes from God the Father of lights (James 1: 17). What are you giving to the Lord? Giving is not just about giving anything; it is about giving

your best and all to the one who owns the whole world. Some argue that since God created everything, then He doesn't have a need but God has a need.

### THE NEEDS OF GOD

God wills that all men will be saved; that is why He gave his Son to die for the sins of the world. God needs you to give in other to spread the message of the cross so that men will be saved from eternal destruction (1 Timothy 2: 4). In order for this to be done, he has provided various means for the gospel to spread. He has raised some as evangelists, pastors, prophets, teachers and apostles to go out and do the work and he has put the needed resources in the hands of others to support those who are going. There are several needs today to advance God's

kingdom here on earth.

God also needs you to be a blessing to others. God created all that man will need in the Garden of Eden before he created man. Man needs these creatures to survive too; the green leaves, the animal etc are all

interdependent on each other for survival. So the concept of God is that we meet each other's need so anyone that does not give will not receive.



### WHY GIVING?

- Giving is God's instruction to man Luke 6: 38 "Give, and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give into your bosom. For with the same measure that ye mete withal it shall be measured to you again." This simply means if you don't give, you can't receive! If you give, you will receive in an overflowing measure.
- 2. God taught us to give by giving his best and all; Jesus Christ. (John 3: 16)
- 3. Giving is living; if you don't give you can't live life fully.
- 4. Giving is profitable; when you give one, you can receive back in many folds.

### WHAT CAN YOU Give?

God gave us all so you can give all as well. You can give your time, life, praise, worship, love, energy, money, property and whatever God has blessed you with. Remember everything came from God.

### WHEN SHOULD YOU GIVE?

In season and out of season, in richness and in lack, every time you have the opportunity to be a blessing to someone or to the work of God. The best time to give is when you have in abundance and when you don't have. Your giving in abundance will speak for you in days to come; it is like a bank saving for the raining day. Your giving in lack or when it is not convenient is a sacrificial giving that can get you God's approval just like the widow in our text or save you in calamity to come like the widow of Zarephath in 1 Kings 17 who saved her life and that of her son by giving her last meal to prophet Elijah. When your seed is not enough to eat, you sow it. **HOW TO GIVE?** 

- 1. Give as unto the Lord (Psalms 29: 1 2)
- 2. Give cheerfully not forcefully, there is no reward for forceful giving (2 Corinthians 9:6 7)
- 3. Give with thanksgiving (Psalms 100:4)
- 4. Give with a grateful heart (1 Thessalonians 5:18)
- 5. Give sacrificially (Acts 2:45)
- 6. Give your best and all (Genesis 22:1 19)
- 7. Give with all your abilities (Luke 21:4)
- 8. Give by faith (Hebrew 11:4)
- 9. Give with expectations.

### **REWARDS FOR GIVING**

You will also receive (Luke 6:38). God has a way of paying back for our giving. It might not be the exact way you sow it like receiving money for giving money. The reason why some people are alive today is because of their continuous giving. You will receive God's approval just like the widow in the reference scripture. Your giving will receive heaven's attention if you give right. It is not all giving that are accepted to God, money or wealth gotten in a sinful way is not acceptable to God. Give from a good source if you want to receive (Genesis 4:4-5).

A generational covenant can be established as a result of right and sacrificial giving, which means giving the best and all. Abraham gave his best and all that he has, his only son Isaac and a divine covenant was established (Genesis 22: 15 - 19)

Will you give God your best and all?



From last edition; we examined vitals keys to a successful marriage and Parenting. Here are the last two keys:

### KEY 3: A COMMITMENT TO GROW IN YOUR SEXUAL INTIMACY

### KEYS TO A SWEET SEXUAL INTIMACY 1st Corinthians 7 vs.1-9,

- 1. Naked and not Ashamed: No beautiful and wonderful sexual intimacy without pure and truthful communication. Genesis 2:25
- 2. Pay attention to it because God delights in it. You must prepare yourself; you must add it to your daily life and do all that is possible to enjoy it to the fullness. Make deliberate effort to include it in your daily routine. Not everyday of course but have a full dose of it. Song of Solomon1vs.13
- 3. Create an atmosphere of romance between each other, talk to each other, be natural, let your self go and let God be glorified. Warning: No sex in Heaven it was Lazarus that was in Abrahams bosom not Sarah, check **Luke 16 vs.23** because we are going to worship him both day and night so you better enjoy it here and now. **Song of Solomon 3vs.1**
- 4. Identify every possible hindrance: Children disturbance, lack of time, Pressure of Job, lots of activities, prayer and fasting, stress etc. Put the kids to bed in good time, work out a schedule, take each other out and have a good evening, help in taking care of your friends kids so that they can also help you likewise.
- 5. Set the right mood. Communicate in love and build emotions from the moment you wake up. Don't wait until night only, be flexible, don't be rigid, no tradition. Sex is not meant for night times alone, whenever you have the opportunity maximize it and God will be greatly praised.
- 6. Buy gifts for each other, treat each other with love, go out, take walks together, do activities together, touch each other, help each other, in

the kitchen, in the room, everywhere and create an atmosphere of true love. Create an atmosphere of fun, joy, go swimming, go walking, go studding the bible together etc.

### **BENEFIT OF A GREAT SEXUAL LIFE**

- 1. Sex helps your spiritual life and particularly that of the man. A satisfied man is not looking around and jumping around, He is relaxed, full of grace and happily smiling ready to fulfill his ministry. Feed him, give him much more, let him relax in your arm, let her relax in your arm, trust God for grace and strength, receive grace and it will take you to a dimension of spiritual stability.
- 2. It's a great exercise it burns about 5 calories per minute. You do not need to run to the gym every day, you can also use this great tool to exercise your body and be fit.
- 3. it improves your sleep. It helps you to sleep well, it helps you to relax better and above all it takes a way Heat and Cold in this winter. Eccl 4 vs.11
- 4. It reduces stress from your body
- 5. It reduces the rate of heart attack.

### KEY4: A COMMITMENT TO A PARENTING SKILLS.

1. Need for Discernment: No great parents can happen without the operations of the gift of discernment. David was a general in battle but could not discern that something was wrong when his son Amnon was having an ungod inordinate affection towards his sister. You

must be able to discern your children as they grow older, you do not have to approve everything they desire, but check with God before approving their choices.2 Samuel 13.

3.

Implement necessary godly discipline when they err. David heard about the actions of Amnon and he failed to correct him, he did not take any action. He did not even bother to invite His daughter that was messed up. He was silent on it and Absalom took over the responsibility of His father and went to the extreme. **2nd Samuel 13vs.2-29.** 

- 3. Need to identify with the children when they are going through hard times and emotional changes. Don't neglect them; don't say all manner of things against them. Sit with your children, share with them, identify with their wrongs, let them find joy and consolation in you both and let them be happy sharing their heart out. David could not invite Tamar His daughter to His palace to pray with her, share with her or even counsel her.
- 4. Pray for your children and invest into them. David could only discipline His children by keeping malice and staying away from them. The best way to discipline your children is not to refuse to talk to them or to keep them away. He kept Absalom away for three years because of his anger towards him. and when he brought him back he never sat down to discuss with him about his wrong doings. Don't operate like that, the children will not know what you believe, they will not know how to respond, they will not know how to follow your values. **2nd Samuel 14.**

### A final word to the Mothers: what will you pass unto your children?? 2nd Timothy 1 vs.5. Will you transmit your faith into your children?

- 1. Lois passed it unto Eunice and Eunice passed it unto Timothy.... What will we pass unto our generation?
- 2. History of Eunice: Acts 16 vs.1-4. She

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was Jew and her husband a Greek. More like an unbeliever.

- **2nd Timothy 3 vs.14-15** : The mother taught him the holy scriptures since he was a child, what are you teaching your child? Timothy was taught by His mother he earned two books to his name in the bible, Samuel was taught from Infancy by His mother he also earned two books in the bible for himself, Peter had his mother in law living with him he also had two books in the bible to his name, John was brought by his mother to Jesus he also had three books to His name. What are you doing, when you are long gone what will the believers say about your children.
  - 4. The brethren spoke well of Him. Acts 16 vs.1-4.
  - 5. Paul wanted him because he was a wonderful instrument for mission.
  - 6. The foundation created by His mother and grandmother made circumcision easy. Paul circumcised Him.

# Tell us about your background, education and salvation experience.

My name is Titilayo Ajoke Badejo. I am born into the family of an erudite man of God and I happened to be the first born of my father. I love God from my childhood and I always want to please him that is why they call me "mama prayer" because I love prayers.

I was born in Ibadan though my parents hail from Ekiti State. I had my primary & secondary education in Ibadan & later proceed to Kwara Polythenics, Kwara State where I studied science laboratory technology. I have a feeling that God has special purpose for my life right from my childhood. Earlier as a minister's daughter, I had responded so many times for altar calls for salvation but in 1992 I made a final decision to accept Jesus fully and since then I had not look back.

# How did you discover the purpose of God for yourlife?

I did not discover the purpose of God for my life until I got married to my husband Evang. Segun Badejo in 1999. I have been in prayer & singing ministry before then as a single but when I got married to my husband who had been into full time drama ministry, I just believed it was his ministry & as a dutiful wife, I kept supporting him. My husband is quiet type & always has little to say at home. But whenever anyone with the same vision visits, they will talk for hours nonstop. This always made me sad.

In 1996, I was encouraged by my husband to attend The Mount Zion Institute of Christian Drama. During one of the Morning Prayer termed Holy Ghost breakfast; our daddy in Lord, Evangelist Mike Bamiloye was led by God to pray for marriages. That was when the anointing and power came upon me to compliment my husband in the drama ministry. In the same year I left my job and joined him on full time in the ministry. Since then, our ministry; The Gideon Mission has been souring on eagles' wing.

# SPECIAL INTERVIEW WITH EVANG. TITLAYO BADEJO



The Challenges of a full time Drama Minister

Finance has always been the major challenge. But I thank God who has given me a man who is not only a husband but a father and brother; God used him to teach me faith.

Many rimes, he will tell me not just have faith& agree with him on any major step we want to take in the ministry and God has been giving me the grace to agree with him. His faith is a challenge to me but I learned that living by faith in the area of finances is always the best. We have embarked on so many missions within& outside Nigeria with little or nothing in our pocket. Our mission to Liberia April 2016 is a perfect example. We boarded flight to Liberia with only a token in our pocket yet so many exploits were done in that country by the grace of God. We have equally produced many movies by faith, so when I have doubts, I have learnt to close my mouth according to my mother in the Lord counsel Evang Gloria Bamiloye and pray instead. God has always surprise us.

# How was it raising children in a faith based ministry full time?

Initially when the children were still young, I do stay back at home and pray for the work. At that time I only had the opportunity of going during long vacation. But now that the children are growing older, I now have more opportunity to go often monitoring the children with phone on daily bases. We have also involved our children in the work so they can understand the work. They always feature in our movies during the school long vacation and we sometimes take them along with us to mission field as well.

### Tell us about your ministry activities

We had been involved in drama mission across Nigeria for many years. Whenever we travel, we minister on stage drama in churches, crusade and conferences. We also go to difficult mission field to help missionaries open up their mission stations to the Lord by staging powerful dramas. At the end of six weeks outreaches, we normally organize drama/film training session for those who are interested. So that after we leave, they will continue with the work of drama evangelism in that particular location. We have trained over a thousand drama ministers across Africa.

### International Drama Mission; when and how?

The door to Africa countries opened in 2011 when we embarked on drama mission to Accra. Kumasi in Ghana. Since then, we had return to Ghana four times for mission. We have equally raised hundred of drama ministers in Nigeria with several movies produced to bless lives. We had equally done same in Cameroon, Kenya and Liberia launching at by faith as we trust God for every resources needed. Today our vision is broader. God has given us the vision of raising stars of another kind. These are drama ministers that will go through the length and breadth of Africa preaching via stage drama and movies pure message of the gospel. The Gideon Drama/film institute holds in Ibadan, Nigeria twice every year with attendance from within and outside Nigeria. In 2016, 250 people graduated from the institute. God has been using our stage drama ministrations to bring many into the kingdom.



remember a time when we ministered in a crusade in one of the Africa countries over 600 people answered altar call one single night. We have produced about 25 movies some are out some are still in the post production stage to God be the glory!

# What are the challenges you faced in interpreting your roles in Christian Drama and Films?

There have been many challenges when I first started acting but I thank God for my husband. He's always there. If I have not married him I might not have been a fulfilled woman. He is always encouraging me, pushing and nudging me gently with assurance that I can do it. When I fail to measure up at times he's never discouraged. He's my mentor and pillar of strength beside God. I can fit in into any role today by the grace of God. Acting in Gospel movie is different from secular movie acting because in secular all you need is talent, but in Gospel movie, anointing is needed most. So staying in God's presence is not negotiable to be a good actress.

### What does it take to make a great lasting Christian movie?

I have not written any script but I have always been learning from my husband that it takes inspiration from God and waiting in his presence to do it. I always take more time to pray for my husband, telling God to give him more inspiration and revelation

### How many movies have you featured in?

I have featured in more than 40 movies in our







ministry and outside. Some are; Majemu Ikoko, Forty years on knee, Kosi Awijare , Edge of success, State of madness, Caught in the storm, No hiding place, Come back home, Virus, Storming seas and lots more.

### Any Advice for Single Sisters & Married?

My advice for the singles is that they should not be in a hurry to marry, because marriage does not worth it if you don't marry well. Marry a man of vision and he will bring out the treasures in you. He will develop you, mould you, make you and if you have a calling or vision, he will nurture it and cherish it and support it. A vision makes a marriage more interesting.

To the married, be an encourager to your husband even when you don't understand his vision, continue to pray and don't be discourage because at the end you will be the one to be celebrated most. And finally patiently endure whatever comes your way don't give up and God will reward all your labors.

# LEAVING A DIVINE LEGACY

There are no gifts from parents to their children more precious than good training and morals. It is better to earn their respect and love by what we do than to force them to unwillingly get it. Legacy is something that is handed down from one period of time to another period of time. It can be something good or bad. It is an ongoing activity, it cannot die in as much as it is well handed down. Divine is something proceeding from God, heavenly. Divine legacy is something heavenly or godly handed down over a period of time. It is something that involves timing too, because it will come to a period that it might be too late to pass on legacy. As parents, knowingly or unknowingly, will exhibit some characters that are being observed by our children. Often times these characters or what we can call behaviours manifest without our knowledge. This happens because they have become part of us and so we do not think twice before we manifest them. The more reason we need to be godly in the first place so that we can manifest and transmit godly characters to our children that are looking at us as role models.

We are looking majorly at the book of 1 Chronicles 28 for this message to be well understood. David was a man after God's heart and so it was easy for him to instruct his son, Solomon in the ninth verse of the book of 1 Chronicle 28, to serve God with a perfect heart and a willing mind just like David his father did. As parents, we should desire to love God with the whole of our hearts, so when we tell our children same it will be easier for them to comprehend. The following points are the derived legacies from the life of David as a godly parent of Solomon.

1. Transparency, honesty and sincerity. David was honest enough to let Solomon and the entire Israelites know that God did not allow him to build the temple for him, neither did he make unnecessary excuse for himself why he was not allowed to build the temple. He told him the truth. David did not only show his strong sides to his son, he also let him know his weakness. As parents that are godly, let our children know when we do something wrong and also let them know that perfection is a thing we work towards. By doing this, the children will know that no one is actually perfect in the real sense of it but can only be with the help of God. A lot of parents push their children academically and fail to appreciate the little efforts the children are making at that moment. Most of these parents performed worst than their children when they were their age but they will never let the children know that instead they complain bitterly why they are not coming first in test. We need to be sincere and honest to them and also understand that the best we can do for them is to encourage them instead of condemnation. David is an example of a sincere parent, he did not withhold the truth from his son and this did not reduce him as parent either, instead it gave Solomon a better understanding why God chose him to build the temple for Him.

2. No form of bitterness or secrecy. In verse 11, the bible says David gave Solomon the pattern of the porch and all others, and the pattern of all he had by the spirit. David did not allow the work of flesh called bitterness to hold him down from giving specific instructions to his son about the building, instead he allowed the spirit of God to guide him. He did not choose to hide the facts from his son despite the fact that he couldn't do this special work for God. Many parents in life have become failures in one way or the other and instead of them to make sure that this act of failure is not repeated in the life of their children, they choose to display nonchalant attitude towards this. We should not let our past failures hinder us from being the perfect parents expected us to be by God. We should not let bitterness of the past hinder us from leaving divine legacy behind for our children. Let the children know the right thing to do in a situation where we as parents have acted wrongly. Do not hide any relevant

ation that will guide their future from m, let the Holy Spirit guide you bitterness.

3. Godly action. Action speaks louder than voice is a common saying. In verses 9 and 10 of our text, just like it was mentioned in the introduction, Solomon was able to understand his father, David, when he was saying serve God with all your heart and mind. David lived such life and Solomon could see that and so it was easier for him to listen to his instruction and follow suit. A lot of parents these days do what they want forgotten that the children are looking at them and forming their personality through what they see. The actions of some parents are "do what I say and not what I do." That cannot work at all. We should lead by example. When we serve God with all that are within us our children will follow same. When we cultivate the habit of being in church at all service days, they will see the necessity to do same. 1 Timothy 4:12.

Special instructions and guidelines. Again we see 4. here how David passed the instructions on how to build the temple to Solomon in verse 11 of our text. Parents are supposed to be everything to their children from caretaker, counsellor, teacher, prophet to many roles we cannot mention now. It is our duty as parents to see that our children become what God ordained them to be. David ensured that his son got the main thing God wanted his son to do, he made it a point of duty that the instructions were handed to him specially and clearly too. He did not joke with it. Psalms 44:1 -4 talked about how the fathers told their generation about God, of what great things He did for them and how He delivered them, then down to verse 4, that generation was able to claim this same God as their king. We need to tell our children about God all the time and guide them to fulfilling His purpose in life. We should feel obligated towards our children achievement and see to it that they become great in life. The basic instructions of life pertaining to life and godliness are the best legacies to leave for our children.

5. Words of encouragement. David encouraged his son, Solomon to be strong and be of good courage. He made it a point of duty to ensure Solomon was prepared psychologically. A lot of times we fail as parents to remove fear from the heart of our children. Most times we make them think life is full of bed of roses. Even the Bible says in this world we will have many troubles, but we should be of good cheer because the Lord has overcome all these for us. Right from their childhood days we must let them know that life is full of ups and downs but they should not be afraid but be encouraged to face any situation in life. With God nothing shall be impossible (Mathew 19:26). When they are faced with difficulty in life, they will remember these words of encouragement we have deposited in their mind and they will make use of them and help them in life. Many parents are just full of words of negativity. Words like you think you can make it, that is too hard, even I tried it and I was not successful etc. Let us build up in them emotional, intelligence and positive vibes to make them strong and achieve in life. And of course praying for them is a strong legacy too.

We cannot afford to raise ungodly children and profess to be Christians. We should ask God to give us all it takes to be godly parents. Timothy was a child raised by godly mother



and grandmother. They both passed down divine legacy unto him, and he was able to demonstrate this faith too. 2 Timothy 1: 3-5. We are writing a story with our lives to our children, let's act well and godly. (Deuteronomy 6:6-9).




profit handsomely for your time and effort.




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

Not at all although when my family members in Nigeria heard that I was getting married; they called to ask me if I was marrying a pastor because that was what they were told. I told them "No" because my husband has not received the

call as at that time. I never desire nor pray to be a pastor's wife. I just wanted to serve God in my own little corner.

### THE CALL

After marriage, I had my first child and later I had a revelation that I later shared with my husband on how God handed a new building to us to oversee. About two weeks later, my husband called on his way to work and shared scripture that he received from the LORD which confirms his calling into ministry. W



fasted and prayed over both revelations for some days and we got direction from the Lord to start a church.

### **HOW DID YOU START?**

The church started in our living room in Murcia Spain in 2008 with a couple who has two children so a total of four adults and three children held the first service of Christ Ground of Truth Mission Int'l.

# WHAT WERE THE CHALLENGES YOU FACED AT THE BEGINNING?

There were fierce oppositions from men of GOD and other people. We were mocked; it went on for some times. I went into prayers and kept on encouraging my husband to move on. I stood by him because I knew clearly that God called him. Then the Church began to grow and later we rented a hall to use to hold Church services.

# WHAT ARE THE CHALLENGES YOU FACED AS A PASTOR'S WIFE?

At the beginning there were no challenges as such until much later. One of the members, a woman who started with us in the sitting room had a health challenge, a serious one that later nearly turned to spiritual case of a strange spirit and she had a nine month old baby with her. She was later taken back home in Nigeria and I was left with the baby at a particular time to care for him for almost a year. It was tough for me as there were side talks. As at the time the father handled over the baby to me, he was infected with rashes and pus were coming out from head to toe, very irritating but I took care of him not minding that my son can get infected as well. It was tough but God helped me.

Everybody except you to be in the spirit all the time; you can't do what others are doing, if you do it becomes a problem as a pastor's wife.

At the home front-my husband is very caring but sometimes he is busy with church activities and his job, I have to remain calm if he is not available. If he is not at home due to church related issues or his secular job, I have to stay awake till he

comes back and attend to him. Sometimes we go out with the children to shop, eat and stroll together.

### WHAT IS YOUR ASSIGNMENT IN THE MINISTRY?

I started preparing the Sunday school material and also teach during Sunday school right from the inception of the church. So as the ministry grows, we had workers joining the Sunday school department handling the classes while I now coordinate them. I also oversee the women ministry of the church as a leader although after eight years I appointed executives to work with me in the women ministry. We hold women prayer meeting once a month and a yearly women program for two days May/June. I also hold women summit every year February/March where we pray for homes. I also minister in word sometimes in the church and also honor invitation for preaching engagement in other churches.

### **FINAL WORD**

Pastor's wives need to be patient, without patient you can't help the man to build. Avoid suspicion, but be sensitive and prayerful. Never go against the vision of your husband and don't stand in his way of growth; support him in prayers so he won't go astray. Encourage your husband from time to time. Above all, submission is very important to your husband, both old and young in the ministry.

### **IHAVEA STORYTOTELL**

I have many stories to tell of God's faithfulness to me and his call upon my life but my focus is on Daughters of Destiny Magazine. In May 2017, our ministry celebrated its 21<sup>st</sup> year anniversary and at that time we have 5 editions of the magazine published. At the inception of the ministry on May  $3^{rd}$  1996, the Lord spoke to me about the magazine among other activities of Daughters of Destiny under the main ministry THE OVERCOMERS EVANGELICAL MINISTRIES INTERNATIONAL. The vision was for Daughters of Destiny to reach all females starting with singles and then married. I was a Senior Secondary School I student of Queen's School Ibadan Nigeria at that time so it was a vision bigger than my age. The passion to reach out to women started during my secondary school days. Ladoke Akintola Akintola University of Science and Technology Ogbomoso Nigeria.



What if I had given up on the vision when there was no money? Money can never stop God's work, there are millions of ways by which we can get his work done if only we can seek God's face and get his direction. My husband had always given me his full support and backing financially, morally and emotionally. He has really made been in ministry very easy for me. I have never had a no you can't go there from him he trust





# Healthy Eating for Women

A balanced diet is a cornerstone of health. Women, like men, should enjoy a variety of foods, such as whole grains, fruits, vegetables, and healthy fats, low-fat dairy and lean protein. But women also have special nutrient needs, and, during each stage of a woman's life, these needs change.

### **Eating Right**

Nutrient-rich foods provide energy for women's busy lives and help to prevent disease. A healthy daily diet includes:

- At least three 1-ounce servings of whole grains such as whole-grain bread, cereal, pasta, brown rice or oats.
- Three servings of low-fat or fat-free dairy products including low-fat or fat-free milk, yogurt or cheese.
- Five to 6 ounces of protein such as lean meat, chicken, turkey, fish, eggs, beans or peas and nuts.
- Two cups of fruits fresh, frozen or canned without added sugar.
- Two-and-a-half cups of colorful vegetables fresh, frozen or canned without added salt.

### **Iron-rich Foods**

Iron is one of the keys to good health and energy levels in women. Iron-rich food sources include red meat, chicken, turkey, pork, fish, kale, spinach, beans, lentils and fortified breads and cereals. Plant-based sources of iron are more easily absorbed by your body when eaten with vitamin C-rich foods. So eat fortified cereal with strawberries on top, spinach salad with mandarin orange slices or add tomatoes to lentil soup.

### Folic Acid During the Reproductive Years

When women reach childbearing age, they need to eat enough folic acid to decrease risk of birth defects. The requirement is at least 400 micrograms of folic acid a day. Be sure to consume adequate amounts of folic acid daily from fortified foods or supplements, in addition to food forms of folate from a varied diet. Citrus fruits, leafy greens, beans and peas naturally contain folate. There are many folic acid fortified foods such as cereals, rice and breads.

### **Daily Calcium Requirements**

For healthy bones and teeth, women need to eat a variety of calcium-rich foods every day. Calcium keeps bones strong and prevents osteoporosis, a bone disease in which the bones become weak and break easily. Some calcium-rich foods include low-fat or fat-free milk, yogurt and cheese, sardines, tofu (if made with calcium sulfate) and calcium-fortified foods including juices and cereals.

### **Foods to Limit**

To keep weight in check at any age, women should avoid a lot of excess calories from added sugars, fat and sugar sweetened beverages..

- Limit regular soft drinks, sugar-sweetened beverages, candy, baked goods and fried foods.
- Opt for low-fat dairy and meat products instead of their full-fat counterparts.

Eat fewer foods that are high in saturated fat — the kind found in fatty meats, sausages, cheese and full-fat dairy products, baked goods and pizza.

### **Balancing Calories with Activity**

Since women typically have less muscle, more fat and are smaller than men, you need fewer calories to maintain a healthy body weight and activity level. Moderately active women need 1,800 to 2,200 calories a day. Women who are more physically active may require more calories.

Exercise is an important part of a woman's health. Regular daily activity helps with weight control, muscle strength and stress management.


Many home at the verge of divorce were restored; marital bliss and peace that have gone sour were also sweetened as the word of God from these great men of God touch marriages and families alike.
